



# Admission Requirements for Doctoral Studies

## General Framework

### TIMELINE

- Registration is possible throughout the year.

### Admission Requirements

- Candidates must have a Master's degree with honors (more than 14/20), or equivalent.

### Pre-admission

- The candidate submits a dissertation project, including a (provisional) topic, a bibliography, and an argumentation. The candidate will demonstrate in a few sentences the originality of their research and their interest in the field.
- The project is analyzed. The candidate will be admitted to the doctoral program when a qualified teacher-researcher has agreed to take on the supervision of the project. The candidate is notified of the decision by email within 2 months.

### Duration of the Program

- The program lasts three years (D1, D2, D3)  
Students work at their own pace, each year can be spread over 24 months (maximum).
- The passage from D1 to D2, then from D2 to D3 is conditional on passing an oral examination, the purpose of which is the continuous progress of the work.

### Administrative Formality

The doctoral student registers in D1. Once they pass the examination at the end of D1, they register in D2. The same applies for D3. Each year of study costs 2800 euro (including if this academic year is spread over two calendar years).
